

Tuesday, October 04, 2005 – Who Can Stop It?

I thank the Lord for this scripture because it is reassuring to me that when God has a purpose, no one, no thing, no trial, no hardship, no fight, no opposition, no doubt, no disbelief, no impossibility, nothing can disannul it. This is not a light statement....and as we are so accustomed to having people tell us what they intend to do regarding a situation....but when God purposes a thing to be, no matter what is going on, it will be.

Have you ever experienced a time in your life when you had your mind made up to do something (get a job at a certain company, live in a certain place, do a certain thing....especially on the weekends, have you ever planned things out down to the minute only to have one thing happen that turns your plans upside down?) God's purposes for your life....will indeed occur. You can't hide from God....if He has called you to do something (and yes, I do believe that He has a purpose for every one in life to do His will....) You may fight it, you may deny it and you may garner supporters to enforce your intention to *never* do this...but I am a living witness that when God says you are (I have to say it) more than a conqueror, suit up my friend because that is what you will be....and everything that happens in your life will bring you to the place God purposed for you to be in.....

Most of the time we really don't want to do, or be, or say, who we really are in God...why? Because it's not what we had purposed for our lives. Even if you aren't convinced, He's still purposed it for you. And HE will allow time, circumstances, other people and His own word to convince you that yes you are what He said. Sometimes we just refuse to acknowledge that God has greater purpose for our lives, than to come to church and sit!!

Your life is supposed to demonstrate God's purpose through your life....His glory is supposed to be revealed through your life....this is why you run (I know I said that was it, but it's still in my heart).....my desire for you is that you embrace God's purpose for you instead of trying to disannul it....Paul wrote this and certainly he experienced enough people trying to disannul God's purpose....they tried but....How do you fight against God and win??? You don't...you step into His purpose telling Him you are willing to do whatever He says...yes, you can go kicking and screaming....but He'll just wait for you to wind down and come to the understanding that He knows why He called you to that purpose (that's why He gave *you* that boss that can't get along with anyone, that's why He gave you the children that just seem to be sooooo needy all of the time, that's why He put it on your heart to reach out to those in depression, that's why He had *your* family members flip out on you, that's why He allowed them to fire or down size *you*, that's why *you* have been crying out before the Lord over someone else's child that is lost, that is why you see such hopeless situations but you keep on praying....the family you have been given, the trials you are experiencing, the frustrations that are at your doorstep.....it's before you and impacting *you because it's part of His purpose for your life*.. The purpose may be for you to be a prayer warrior....would you sign up for that if you knew that it meant you (and those around you) would experience deep spiritual battles? The purpose may be for you to be a great soul winner for Christ...would you sign up for that if you that it meant you would see such devastation that your heart breaks and you live with the weight of laboring and birthing souls(all souls don't come easily...some you work with and work with and work with....), The purpose may be for you to encourage others....would you sign up for that if you had to experience being

discouraged, forgotten, lonely....who better to be a person with purpose than the one who knows the pain and agony of a situation.

So, who can stop the purpose of God for your life.....no one! Not even you. If He purposed "it" for your life, "it" can't be disannulled.

For the Lord of hosts hath purposed and who shall disannul it? (2 Kings 14:27a)
